Principal's Report

Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to school for the final term of the 2020 school year. I hope you were able to enjoy some valuable family time over the break and that your children have come back to school refreshed and ready for a busy term. It is hard to believe that we are at this point in the year, as we start to prepare for end of year activities and events. While this is an exciting term and an exciting time of year, it is of the utmost importance that our students ensure that learning remains at the fore, and that they put their best effort into everything they do this term.

Virtual Assembly

Last Friday, we held our second very successful Virtual Assembly in place of our regular combined assemblies. At this event, we awarded and celebrated the achievement of our students who achieved Silver and Gold Awards, as well as SRL Badges and Banners.

We also had the opportunity to award our Poetry Recital winners from Term One. Congratulations to all students who received an award at this assembly. We will be holding another Virtual Assembly later this term (approximately Week 6 or 7), so please ensure your child hands in their awards if they are due to receive a Silver or Gold Award or an SRL Badge of Banner. Selective High School

Last week, all Year 5 students were given a note regarding Selective High School placements for 2022. Selective high schools cater for academically gifted students with high potential who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic standard. Selective high schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, and by using specialised teaching methods. Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 11 March 2021. If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school

entry in 2022, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address). Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available in late September 2020 at https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.

The application website opens at that link on 13 October 2020 and closes on 16 November 2020. You must apply before the closing date. There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after 13 October 2020. You must submit only one application for each student. Please inform the school if you are intending to make an application for your child.

Tell Them From Me

This term, we will be designing our new four-year Strategic Improvement Plan 2021-2024. We will be seeking your feedback in a variety of ways to help shape our directions for the next four years. The Partners in Learning parent survey is part of the Tell Them From Me suite of surveys on student engagement. We are excited to announce we will are rolling out the new Online Enrolment System from Monday, 26 October 2020.


