Principal's Report

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Term Three! We have had a very successful start to the term at Picton Public School, and have welcomed a number of new students and families to the Picton PS community. We all play a role in maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment at school and must continue to take all advice seriously.

Playground Work

In the last newsletter of Term Two, I mentioned that we were having some work completed to our playground. Over the break, we had playground markings completed including updates to our netball court, basketball court and handball courts. The most impactful updates have been our wonderful and colourful handball courts. The new courts certainly brighten up the asphalt area and are spaced out enough to ensure students are able to play safely, without interfering in others' games. Family Partnership Meetings
