<p><i>I am SAFE when I.....</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow school rules and listen to teacher's instructions and directions. Keep my environment clean and to report any problems that I am aware of. Report incidences of bullying behaviour to teachers. Ensure that I do not bring weapons or illegal substances to school. Follow safety procedures if an emergency arises. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There will be a teacher supervising all activities, including the playground and enforcing school rules to keep us safe. My environment will be safe, well-maintained and clean. I will not be threatened or bullied by other students and be given strategies to deal with it if it occurs. I will be protected from dangerous situations. I will practise emergency procedures so I know what to do.
<p><i>I am RESPECTFUL when I.....</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look after the property of other and the school. Accept the decision made by staff when all circumstances have been investigated. Wear full school uniform as decided on by the P & C. Include other children in games. Be polite and use appropriate language. Not to tease, laugh at, bully or hurt the feelings of others. Always act responsibly and sensibly when representing the school. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My property is safe and won't be used without my permission. I will be able to tell my side of the story to school staff. The uniform will be comfortable, allow me to play and be practical for all activities. Other children will welcome my participation in play situations. Other children will treat me kindly. I will not be judged on a personal level and be respected for my differences. I will be given appropriate opportunities to attend excursions, sporting activities and other activities.
<p><i>I am a LEARNER when I.....</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Try my best to complete the work that is given to me. Listen to instructions and information. Ensure that I do not disrupt the learning environment of the class or group. Question politely and to accept the decision made. Try to start each day with a positive attitude. Am a role model to other children and help them understand the rules of the school. Understand that all children learn at different rates. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My classroom will be well organised with work at different levels. I will be encouraged to ask questions to further my knowledge or to explain something that I don't understand. My learning area will be settled and well structured so that I am able to concentrate. My opinions will be listened to and respected. The activities given to me will be stimulating, varied and achievable. I will be acknowledged for 'doing the right thing' and being a good school citizen. I will be accepted by my peers for my individual learning ability.
